In your lesson plan, detail your process for assessment (oral quiz, written quiz, project, etc.) and get feedback on what worked and didn't work for students. Determine what values will be used to define your lesson's success (ex: students are able to display knowledge comprehension in line with the learning objective 80% of the time).

How to Write a Lesson Plan: A Teacher's Guide

At the beginning of every lesson, write your lesson plan goal at the top. It should be incredibly simple. Something like, "Students will be able to identify different animal body structures that enable eating, breathing, moving, and thriving." Basically, it's what your students can do after you're done with them!
