Lymphedema refers to swelling that generally occurs in one of your arms or legs. Sometimes both arms or both legs swell. Lymphedema is most commonly caused by the removal of or damage to your lymph nodes as a part of cancer treatment. It results from a blockage in your lymphatic system, which is part of your immune system.

Lymphedema is swelling in a part of your body where lymphatic fluid builds up more than normal. It can develop when lymph nodes are removed or when lymph vessels that carry lymphatic fluid are missing, damaged, or not developed. When lymph fluid does not drain properly, it causes swelling in any part of the body, most commonly in arms and legs.

Lymphedema refers to swelling of any part of the body due to poor functioning of the lymphatic channels that drain away excess fluid. It can occur due to damage to the lymph nodes or blockage of the lymphatic channels. In other cases, it is present from birth as part of an inborn abnormality.

## Lymphedema: Symptoms, Signs, Causes & Treatment

Lymphedema occurs when lymph fluid collects in the arm (or other area such as the hand, fingers, chest/breast or back), causing it to swell (edema). The swelling may be so slight it 's barely seen or felt. Or, it may be so great the arm grows very large. In severe cases, lymphedema can cause pain and limit movement.
