The theory sees consciousness evolving gradually over the past 500 million years as a solution to a fundamental problem facing any nervous system: too much information to process. First, and even before the central brain, came selective signal enhancement (SSE), the ability for neurons which shout the loudest to impact the organism's behavior. Very primitive nervous systems, such as the hydra's, do not possess it, condemning their owners to respond to all stimuli in a similar way.
